Please keep the following in mind as you begin to think about your schedule for next school year:

- You must earn THREE credits in the same arts area to meet graduation requirements
- ALL seniors must have at least one arts' class on their schedule

In our effort to make sure you are as prepared as possible when we begin course selection in mid to late March, below you will find a listing of our arts' electives with specific requirements and/or audition details for acceptance into the course, even if you are already a major in that specific arts area. Of course, non-majors are welcome to enroll; however, you must follow the specific requirements outlined below and adhere to all deadlines. Dance

Acceptance into any elective dance class is based on the student's audition, as well as space availability, with current Dance majors receiving first priority. Instrumental Music

Visual Art

Students interested in taking an art class, who did not assess for Visual Arts, **must submit an eight piece portfolio to Mrs. DeGregory by March 29**th to enroll in any visual art course. The portfolio can be composed on drawing paper or in a visual journal. Vocal Music

<u>Vocal Music</u> - Students must pass the Cab Vocal Assessment to be eligible to take this course (visit the Cab website to view assessment requirements). Students need to sing a classical song (please bring sheet music) and a Broadway song (with sheet music). Students will also be tested on their sight-singing abilities, sing a melody taught by the instructor while a countermelody is sung, reproduce pitches played by instructor and identify pitches on both treble and bass staves. <u>Musical Theatre</u> - Rising juniors and seniors may audition afterschool <u>March 20th & 21st</u>. A sign-up is available outside of Mrs. Eldreth's room. Be prepared to sing 16 bars of a Broadway song, do a cold reading, and learn a short dance. The audition is only open to rising juniors and seniors.

<u>Jazz Choir</u> - The JazzChords of Calloway high school jazz choir is a performance group for more advanced singers who desire an intense small group choral experience. Previous experience singing in a choir is required but previous jazz experience is not. The choir has about twenty performances a year and students are graded in part on their availability to perform at a significant number of these events. The choir can be supported by a rhythm section of bass, piano, drums and guitar if these musicians are available to join the choir.
